#### **50 YEARS TOGETHER**

Bocconi University values global education and invites cross-cultural sharing of ideas and perspectives. Bocconi was among the first Italian universities to establish exchange agreements with universities in other countries. In 1974, Bocconi signed agreements with a French university and one in the US. These agreements were the initial steps toward building an international student body that includes both students enrolled in degree programs and exchange students. Today Bocconi is proud to partner with 288 universities worldwide.

Bocconi's ties with American universities are well established and growing. Indeed, the connections with American institutions of higher education constitute a valuable component of the University's international relationships.


